



Cohesion policy eligibility 2021-2027 based on 2015, 2016, 2017 GDP average






INTEGRATED TERRITORIAL DEVELOPMENT (NEW CPR ART. 22)

Support from the ESIF to Islands is possible and can be provided in a tailor made way via integrated territorial and local development in the form of:

- ITI: when a territorial strategy receives funding from <u>multiple priorities</u>, or even programmes, funds or Policy Objectives (POs)
- CLLD: when a local strategy is designed and implemented using a specific bottom-up method
- Other territorial tool/s > > New PO 5 "Europe closer to citizens"
















